

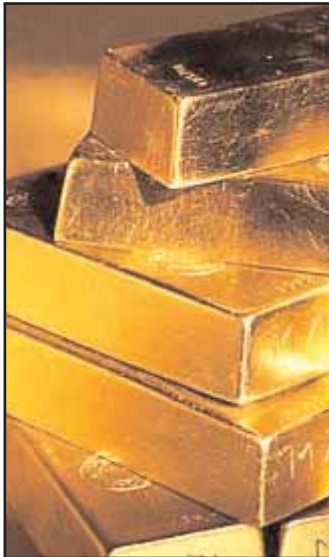

issue is yet again packed full of news and views and as always, your knowledge will be put to the test if you want to win a bottle of Champagne and feature in these pages.

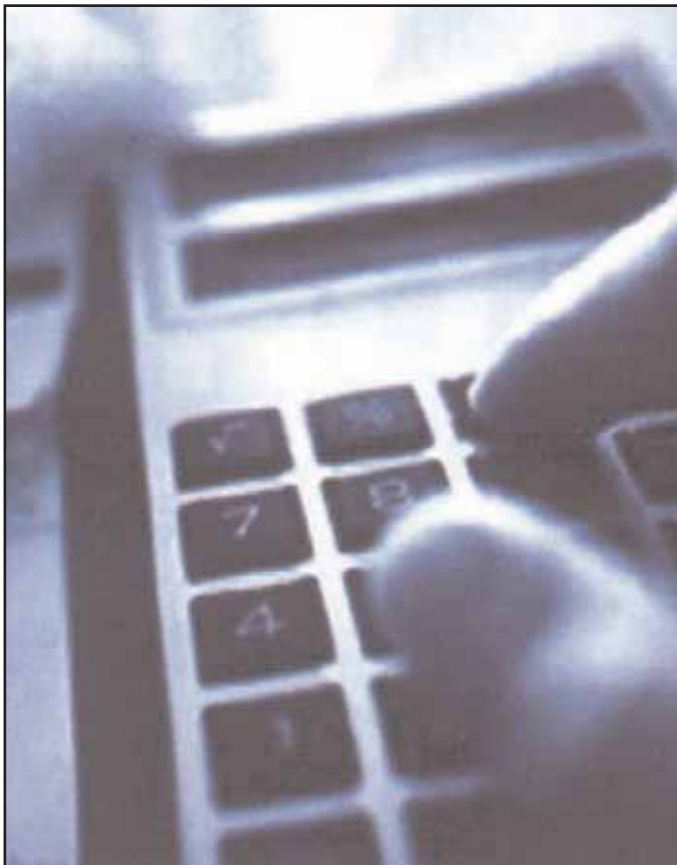
So, as we now start the count down to the next landmark, 75, please enjoy the read.

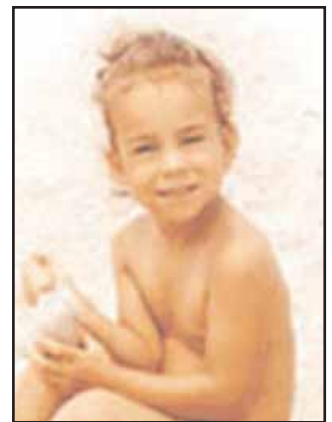
